

fifty-seven.	
One hundred twenty-five	
minus thirty-two equals	
ninety-three.	

Seventy-one minus thirty-	
three equals thirty-eight.	
Six times twelve equals	
seventy-two.	
Eight times eight equals	
sixty-four.	
Thirty-six divided by nine	
equals four.	
One hundred twenty-five	
divided by twenty-five	
equals five.	
Eighty-three percent.	
Ninety point five percent.	
[Zero] point four five	
Two point three equals two and three tenths.
