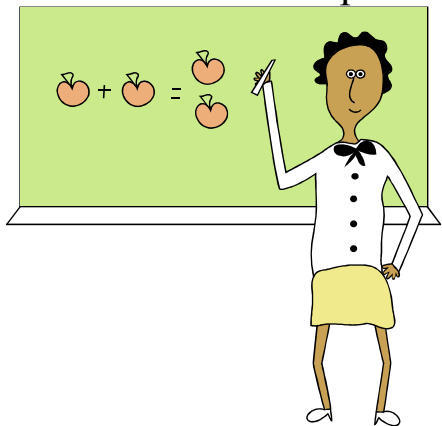


EAP 1221 – Reading Level II Quantitative Literacy Exercises

1. **Write** the following numerical expressions using mathematical symbols.

Example:

Numerical Expressions	Mathematical Symbols
	1 + 1 = 2

One plus one equals two.

Now it's your turn:

Thirteen plus eight equals twenty-one.	
Forty-eight plus nine equals fifty-seven.	
One hundred twenty-five minus thirty-two equals ninety-three.	

Seventy-one minus thirty-three equals thirty-eight.	
Six times twelve equals seventy-two.	
Eight times eight equals sixty-four.	
Thirty-six divided by nine equals four.	
One hundred twenty-five divided by twenty-five equals five.	
Eighty-three percent.	
Ninety point five percent.	
[Zero] point four five	
Two point three equals two and three tenths.
